

The **Getty Villa** is the perfect locale. Along with its stunning art, architecture and gardens, the site is accessible and the hosts are so welcoming. The museum focuses on early Italian and Greek art. The villa is a re-creation of an Italian country house. Four tranquil gardens include fountains, arbors and reflecting pools.

Clients and guests should arrive between **10:30 am and 11 am**. We will meet in the picnic area, which is flagged on the **map**. Participants are invited to enjoy a casual lunch on arrival or at their convenience. You may bring your own picnic lunch, or purchase food at The Café at the Getty Villa.

Departure time is **2 pm**. Families, groups and volunteers are welcome to stay as long as they wish after checking out. The Getty Villa closes at **5 pm**.

Parking is free for those who are preregistered, and oversize vans can be accommodated. Families and groups who wish to participate should **register** by **March 26** or by calling  [\(818\) 587-9450, ext. 120](tel:(818)587-9450). All participants must be accompanied by a staff member or family member.

We have eight partner organizations for this event: New Horizons, TLC for the Blind, PathPoint, TASC, Ability First, Easter Seals, Exceptional Children's Foundation, and Tierra del Sol. Partners help spread the word, sharing information and distributing fliers to their clients, families, staff and community. Groups of clients and staff or family relish the friendship and fun of the day.

the Art Quest and other activities, and to help push wheelchairs and interact with clients. Volunteers will have their own special tour beforehand to learn the best routes and offerings for the participants. Volunteers should meet at **9:45 am** for training and the tour. Don't come too early. The gates don't open until **9 am**.

## Special Olympics World Games

Ceremonies at Cal State University Northridge Kick Off Prelims

Valley Village Executive Director Debra Donovan joined other San Fernando Valley leaders and community members and the press for a major announcement March 20 at **California State University**, Northridge, regarding the **Special Olympics World Games**. Rafer Johnson, 1960 Olympic Gold Medalist and founder of the Special Olympics, Southern California, was among the dignitaries present.

CSUN, in partnership with Chatsworth, Northridge, Reseda, Tarzana and Woodland Hills, announced that it will host five delegations of athletes with intellectual disabilities and their coaches from around the world. CSUN will be home and training camp for nearly 500 athletes from six countries from July 21-24. The Games will be July 25 through Aug. 2.

The Host Towns will provide food, transportation and special events for the athletes and coaches. More than 7,000 athletes and 3,000 coaches representing 177 countries, along with 30,000 volunteers and 500,000 spectators, are expected in Los Angeles. The Special Olympics World Games thus will be the largest sports and humanitarian event anywhere in the world this year, and the single largest event in Los Angeles since the 1984 Olympics.
